Will you talk about Him on Monday?

- *Acts 4:11-12: "This Jesus is the stone that was rejected by you, the builders, which has become the cornerstone. And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved."*
- *Acts 10:38: "...How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power. He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him."*
- Jesus is both Lord and Christ! He should be center of our lives as He was for the saints in the first century. Let us share the good news with others. Let's talk about Him all the time. Let's meditate on His sacrifice and what the resurrection means to us. Let's talk about Him and worship Him everyday.
